

Cure your Clay Chimenea



Cure your own... Chimenea

Curing your clay chimenea helps to prevent cracking and general heat damage and should be done prior to using your chimenea for the first time.

- 1 First, spread an even layer 5-8 cm deep of sand in the base of the chimenea. Ensure this layer is always present when the chimenea is in use.
- 2 Place a small quantity of kindling and newspaper on top of the sand.
- 3 Light the paper first, and allow the fire to build and spread.
- 4 Add a small log to the slow burning fire.
- 5 When the log has burnt out, allow the chimenea to cool.
- 6 Repeat the whole process a minimum of three times.
- 7 Soot from the fire will rise into the natural cracks of the chimenea, and seal the pores, reducing the chance of cracking.
- 8 Most of all, enjoy your chimenea!
