'Chinese evergreen'

Aglaonema

A very adaptable plant, it tolerates low light and dry air better than most other house plants. One thing it doesn't like is cold air. It suffers when exposed to temperatures below 55°F/13°C. Put your plant in a spot where it won't get cold drafts from doorways or windows.

Sunlight: Low light. Too much light may cause its leaves to fade.

Water: Keep potting mix evenly moist. Consistently moist soil will keep this plant happy. In fact, it can grow in water alone.

Humidity: Average indoor humidity levels. It will tolerate low humidity. Don't mist, it will cause spots on its leaves.

Temperature: Normal room temperatures (65-75°F/18-24°C).

Feed: From spring through summer, feed monthly with a balanced fertilizer diluted by half.

Repotting: This plant grows best when its roots are slightly pot-bound. When repotting, move to a pot that's only 2in (5cm) larger.

Caution: The sap of this plant is poisonous. Keep it away from children and pets who may play with or chew on its foliage.
