

'Ginseng Fig'

Ficus ginseng

Ginseng Fig has a prominent grey trunk. Rounded, evergreen leaves complete the look for this fascinating houseplant.

Sunlight: Ficus ginseng can tolerate low light conditions, but thrives best in well-lit areas with natural light.

Water: Allow the top inch of soil to dry out between watering. Don't leave it sat in water, as Ginseng cannot stand soggy soil.

Humidity: Average room humidity. Will enjoy being misted regularly.

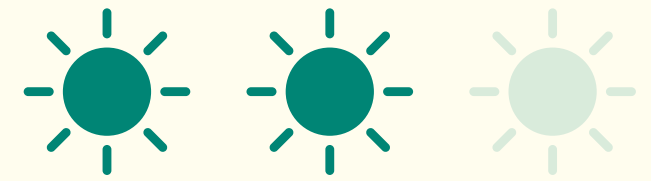
Temperature: Average room temperatures 65-75°F/18-24°C.

Feed: Feed monthly from spring through to autumn, with a balanced liquid fertilizer, diluted by half.

Repotting: Every other year during the summer.

Top Tip: Pinch the leaves to develop a good-looking crown. A good rule of thumb is for every six new leaves that grow, pinch off two. Turn your Ginseng a quarter turn each week, so that the growth is kept symmetrical.
