'Dwarf Umbrella Tree' Schefflera arboricola

If you're looking for height and lushness, Schefflera is for you. Schefflera is popular for it's tolerance of neglect! Schefflera can grow up to 6ft tall, but you can cut off the trunk at any height. It will sprout new leaves from just below where it was cut. Pinching off the growing tips will promote branching.

Sunlight: Bright light, no direct sun. Turn plant occasionally to encourage even growth.

Water: Allow the top inch of soil to dry out in between watering. Yellow leaves are a sign of overwatering. Drooping leaves usually indicate that the soil is too dry.

Humidity: Average indoor humidity. Will benefit from misting in winter, when the air is dry from central heating.

Temperature: Average to warm room temperatures 65-75°F/18-24°C.

Feed: Feed monthly with a balanced liquid fertilizer, diluted by half.

Repotting: May need repotting anually. Older ones every 2 - 3 years in well draining compost.

Top Tip: Doesn't like to be moved around and may drop its leaves if exposed to cold or hot drafts.
