

Boston Fern

One of the most popular fern species, the Boston Fern is an excellent air purifier for airborne germs, mould and bacteria.

Sunlight: Place in a spot with partial shade and avoid direct sun.

Water: Boston ferns need consistently moist but not sodden soil so water regularly to keep the compost moist.

Humidity: This plant requires high humidity so make sure to mist daily. Or even better, place it in a naturally humid room like a bathroom or kitchen.

Temperature: Room temperature between 14°C - 24°C.

Feed: Feed every 2 weeks.

Repotting: Repot in spring, only when the roots have filled the container.

Top Tip: Give the plant a quarter turn every week or so to expose all of the sides to light.
