Water: When watering, ensure thorough saturation and allow the top inch of soil to dry out before watering again. During winter, maintain slightly moist soil but avoid overwatering.

Temperature: It thrives in average to warm temperatures, ranging from 18 to 29°C.

Feed: During spring to autumn, feed it weekly and monthly during winter.

Repotting: Repotting is recommended in spring when the roots fill the pot, using a container with drainage holes to avoid waterlogging.
