

Rubber Plant

Rubber plants are one of the most popular houseplants for their luscious shiny leaves and unfussy nature. This easy to grow plant comes in a variety of colours and sizes, making them a great way to elevate your home decor.

Sunlight: Place in bright but not direct light, at least a few feet away from windows that get direct sunlight.

Water: Keep the compost moist but be careful not to overwater.

Humidity: Their leaves can hold a lot of moisture, so normal room humidity is just fine.

Temperature: Normal room temperature between 16°C - 24°C. Keep out of draughts.

Feed: Feed once a month during spring and summer.

Repotting: Rubber plants like to be slightly pot bound, so only repot in spring when the roots are growing out of the holes in the bottom. Don't repot when the leaves are shredding as this can sometimes cause more problems.

Top Tip: Wipe the leaves with a cloth to keep dust away.
