Remove Weeds From your Garden



As the weather warms up and rain showers fall weeds start to grow with gusto. To maintain a tidy Patio or Drive you will need to control your weeds. This can be done quickly by pulling them up or applying a fast acting weed killer, but some of your root could be left intact which would result in the weed quickly returning.

For longer lasting results we recommend using **Garden Rootkill Weedkiller Concentrate**, it is a multi purpose weed killer which kills annual or deep rooted perennial weeds such as nettles, thistles and dandelions. Being a systemic weed killer it is absorbed by the leaves and spreads throughout the weed and is taken deep down into the roots.

The best time to do this is when the weeds are actively growing, and have a good amount of leaf area so as much of the weed killer is absorbed as possible. It should be applied in dry weather as if it rains within 6 hours another application may be needed.

Weeds should start to show effects a few weeks after application depending on the weather and the type of weed. Persistent weeds such as bindweed can be treated, but may need more than 1 application.
