

'Peace Lily'

Spathiphyllum

Of all the flowering house plants, Peace Lily care is probably the easiest. In fact, it tolerates average indoor conditions better than many house plants. Blooms can appear year-round, and each one lasts for weeks.

Sunlight: Bright light, but no direct sun. Will tolerate low light, but may bloom poorly.

Water: Keep soil evenly moist.

Humidity: Medium – high. Increase humidity by misting the plant frequently, or placing it on a tray of wet pebbles.

Temperature: Average room temperatures (65-75°F/18-24°C).

Feed: Feed monthly in spring and summer with a balanced liquid fertilizer.

Repotting: Likes to be slightly pot bound. Divide every 5 years or when necessary.

Flower Care: No blooms? Plants that fail to bloom usually aren't getting enough sunlight. Move your plant to a brighter location. Older plants should be divided to encourage blooms.

Top Tip: Keep its leaves dust-free by wiping them with a damp cloth.

Caution: The sap of this plant is poisonous. Keep it away from children and pets who may play with or chew on its foliage.
