

'ZZ Plant'

Zamioculcas

ZZ plant makes a great room accent with its upright fleshy stems and glossy leaves. This slow-growing houseplant is tolerant of some neglect and low light levels.

Sunlight: Bright to low light. Keep it out of direct sunlight, which can scorch the leaves.

Water: Zamioculcas hates to be overwatered. To avoid soggy soil, allow the top 2 inches of compost to dry out before watering. Don't leave it sat in water.

Humidity: Average indoor humidity.

Temperature: Cool to average room temperatures 60-75°F, 16-24°C.

Feed: Feed every other month, with a balanced liquid fertilizer diluted by half.

Repotting: Once a year in spring. Only go up one pot size. For an older plant, repot every 2 - 3 years.

Top Tip: Keep the leaves clean by gently wiping them with a damp cloth. Don't use leaf shine products, which can damage the plant.

Caution: All parts of this plant are poisonous. Keep it away from children and pets who may play with or ingest it.
